URGENT NEED

While SOAR's aircraft was flying for Bible camps here in Alaska, the left propellor governor failed causing the left engine to overspeed shortly after take-off. Thankfully, the plane managed to turn around and land safely. Unfortunately, according to the manufacturer, this requires a complete tear down and inspection of the left engine and propellor. The cost to accomplish this is about \$16,000 for the engine and an additional \$5,000 for



the propellor. This amount includes outside labor and replacement parts that cannot be



reused. This aircraft is vitally important for SOAR's continuing ministry with partners in Alaska well as being available for flights to Chukotka. That means to be able to repair this plane and keep it actively involved in the ministry we need to raise \$21,000. Would you be willing to partner with us in getting this aircraft back in the air so that we can continue its vital role in ministry?
