There was a "Beard Tax" in Russia during Peter the Great's Reign, paid by everyone who had a beard.



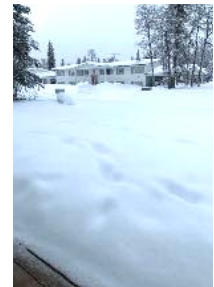

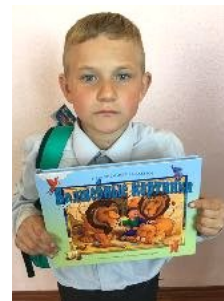
## What's Happening at SOAR?
