Orphans came here for two weeks by themselves and also with their guardians - even from distant villages. Grandmothers and mothers of large families came on behalf of their families. Some traveled by foot 7-10km from villages where public transportation does not go.

At the same time, missionaries packaged and delivered food to poor large families, foster families, and elderly widows.





Bishop Ivan and the Abkhazian church asked Christian pediatricians from Russia to come to Abkhazia - COVID-19 had been affecting the children.
